

under Section 482 of Cr.P.C cannot hold enquiry and record any findings on the merit of the case.

8. Having regard to the evidence at this stage, prima facie there are sufficient materials to proceed against the petitioner for the charge under Section 307 IPC. It is open for the petitioner to urge all his contentions by way of the defence and the trial Court is required to consider them. In view of the matter, I find no ground to entertain this petition. Hence, the petition is rejected.

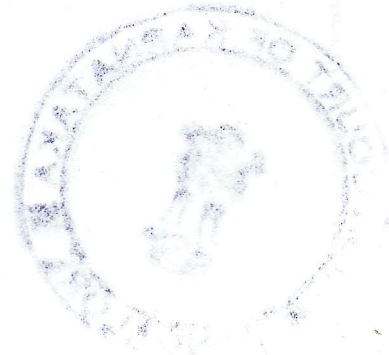
